Attached is a tabulation reflecting your institution's share of the fiscal year (FY) 2009 formula allocation for the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP) appropriated under section 3(d) of the Smith-Lever Act. These funds are distributed according to the statutory formula under section 1425(c) of the National Agricultural Research, Extension, and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (NARETPA) (7 U.S.C. 3175(c)).

Section 7116 of the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (FCEA) amended section 1425 of the NARETPA to revise the EFNEP formula. Additional information about the revised EFNEP Formula is available at

and will be included in the Part I. A of the FY 2009 EFNEP Formula Grant Opportunity (FGO).

CSREES is soliciting for these Applications via Formula Grant Opportunities (FGOs) which will provide instructions for the completion of these application forms. CSREES will notify eligible institutions when the instructions and forms are available on the Grants.gov site. CSREES will release the FY 2009 EFNEP FGO – Final within seven (7) days of the transmission of this memorandum.

These funds will be made available on a quarterly basis through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Payment Management System.
